- Target Removal
- Remove the means to Commit Crime
- Reduce the Payoff
- Access control
- Surveillance
- Environmental Design
- Rule Setting
- Increase the Chance of being Caught
- Deflecting Offenders

Making Suffolk a safer place to live, work, travel and invest

Home Security Survey

- Start with the perimeter
- Encourage natural surveillance
- Keep front fences to 3ft and vegetation clear



Home Security Survey

- Rear fences/walls should be at least 6ft high
- Trellis
- Prickly plants
- Climbing aids



Home Security Survey

- Gates should be 6ft tall
- Lockable top and bottom
- Avoid climbing aids



Home Security Survey

Don't make it easy for them!
Remove all tools/bricks from
the garden



Home Security Surveys



- Dusk to dawn lighting
- PIR limitations



Home Security Surveys

Windows above flat roofs and next to drain pipes should be kept shut and locked.



Home Security Surveys

- Sheds/outbuildings
- Quality locks
- Secure windows
- Hide valuables
- Alarm
- ID property
- Additional security inside
- Green house



Home Security Surveys



- Condition of the door and frame
- 5 lever mortise lock BS 3621
- Mortise bolts
- Rim locks



Home Security Surveys

Lock Snapping

- Not a major problem here yet....
- What should we recommend
- Euro cylinders can be replaced with a TS007 3 star cylinder



Home Security Surveys



- Chain
- Only to be used when answering the door
- Secure ring – UPVC doors



Home Security Surveys



- Spyhole
- Is it used?
- Can you see through it?



Home Security Survey

- Condition of window and frame
- Locks – used?
- Check warranty
- Shut when room vacant
- PAS 24





Home Security Surveys

- French doors
- Vulnerable
- Add bolts (hinge)
- Screw shut if not used



Home Security Surveys



Patio doors

- Check snugness
- Add locks
- Rhino bars



Home Security Surveys



Alarms

- Audible only
- Monitored
- Professional fit from NSI or SSAIB

Home Security Surveys



CCTV

- Quality
- Storage
- Retrieval
- Data Protection
- RIPA
- No dummies!



Home Security Surveys



Timer switches

- Lights and a radio
- Use all the time – not just when you are out

- safety awareness
- neighbours looking out for each other
- build a sense of community

Key benefits of being in a NW scheme

- The most successful crime reduction initiative..... ever
- less likely to be a victim of crime and helps reduce the fear of crime
- improves awareness of personal safety and security of your home and property
- neighbours united in awareness, look out for each other

Work in progress

National level

- CIO status confirmed
- development of working partnerships

Local (Suffolk) level

- now 18 months post the 2016 police review
- change, challenges, and adjustment
- new ways of working
- schemes are helping themselves - not just the police

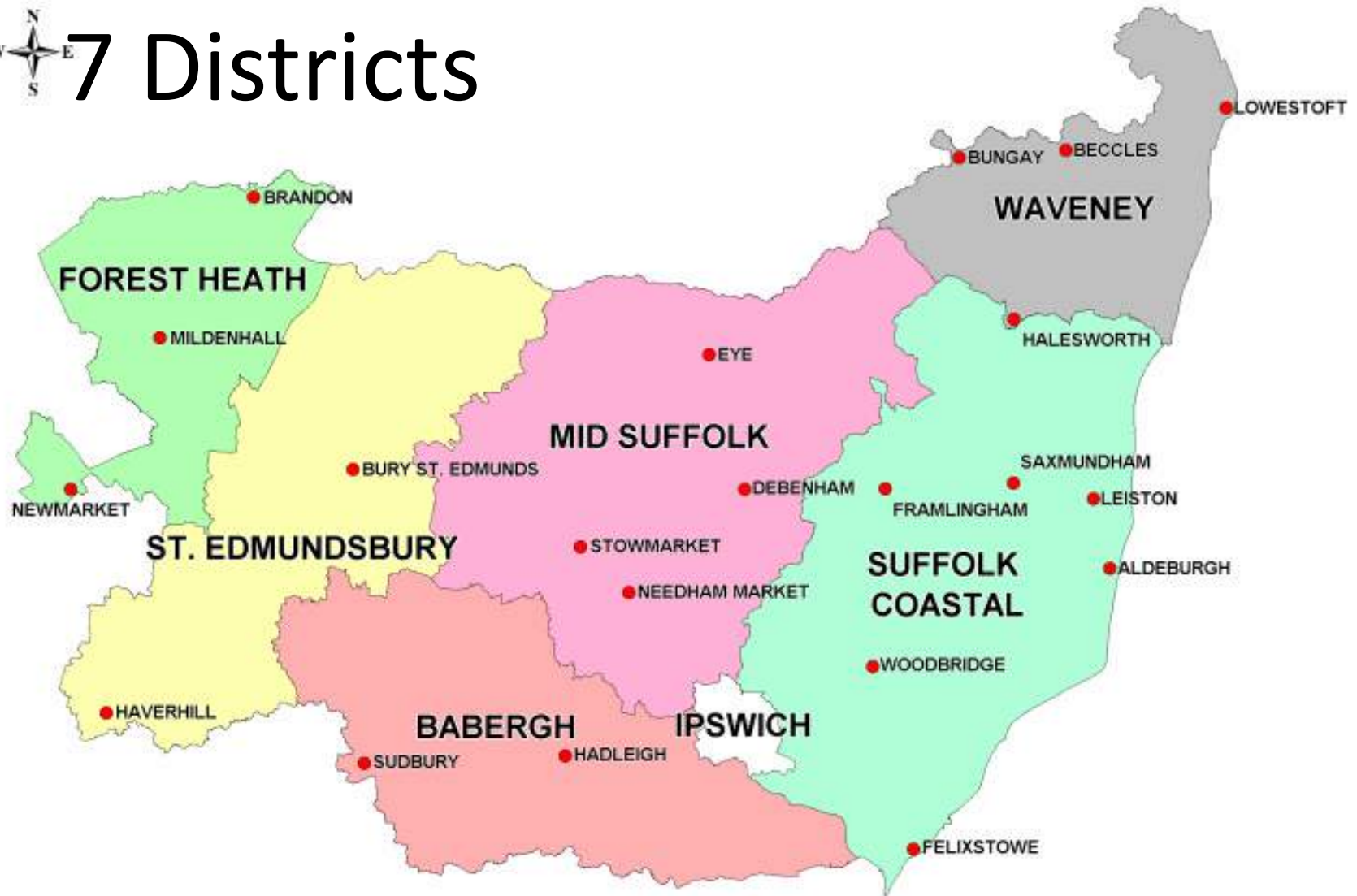

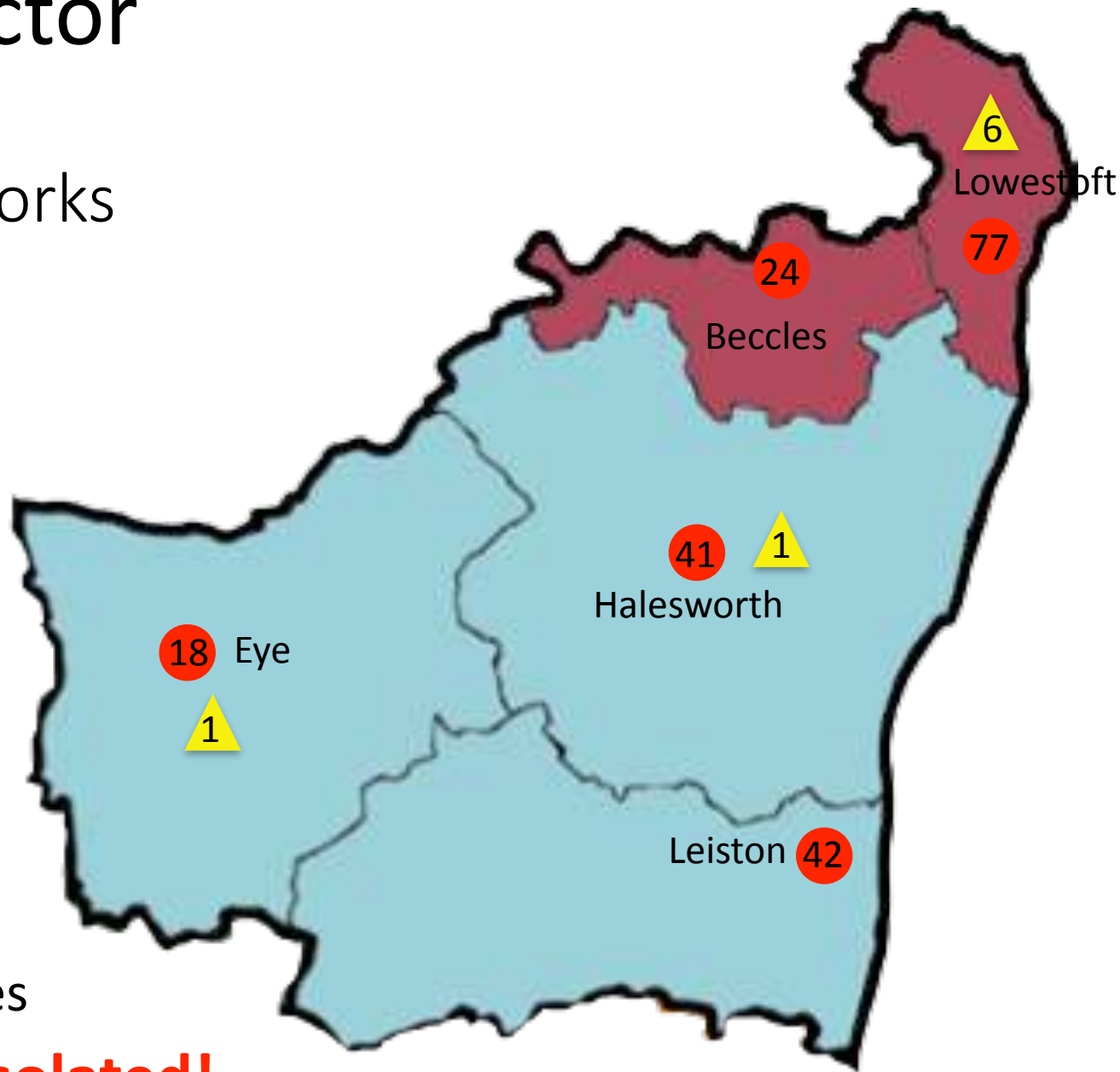

The additional benefits of being in a NW area network

- new schemes become part of an established community network
- local network provides a more “personal” relationship
- more meaningful information (local knowledge) shared
- helps create closer communities and improves community spirit
- easier lines of communication
- potential stronger relationship with SNT
