



NHW NETWORK AREA B - LOCAL CRIME STATS FOR NOVEMBER 2021

Just released (www.police.uk – street level crime map), please see below for the recorded crimes that took place in or near villages in our local Bury St Edmunds **Area B** covering the **6 parishes of Bradfield Combust with Stanningfield, Bradfield St Clare, Bradfield St George, Little & Great Whelnetham, Rushbrooke with Rougham and Nowton**. *Crimes in Hawstead, Cockfield and Lawshall though outside of Area B are also reported here.*

The Bury St Edmunds police reporting area (53 parishes & 9 town wards) saw **436** recorded crimes in the month of **November**; reported crimes in/near the parishes mentioned above include:

Cockfield: 1 x B; 3 x V/S; 1 x PO; 1 x O

Lawshall: 1 x V/S; 1 x OT

Rougham: 3 x V/S; 1 x ASB; 1 x CDA; 1 x PO; 1 x OT; 1 x O

Sicklesmere: 1 x CD/A; 1 x ASB; 1 x V

Overnight on 1st Dec. – 17,500 litres of diesel stolen from Rougham Industrial Estate.

Overnight on 4th Dec. – power tools stolen from a barn in Tuffields Road, Wepstead.

(ASB = Anti-Social Behaviour; B = Burglary; BT = Bicycle Theft; CD/A = Criminal Damage/Arson; D = Drugs; O = Other Crime; O/T = Other Theft; PO = Public Order; R = Robbery; S = Shoplifting; TP = Theft from Person; V = Vehicle Crime; V/S = Violence or Sexual; W = Weapons Possession).
