



NHW NETWORK AREA B - LOCAL CRIME STATS FOR FEBRUARY 2022

Just released (www.police.uk – street level crime map), please see below for the recorded crimes that took place in or near villages in our local Bury St Edmunds **Area B** covering the **6 parishes of Bradfield Combust with Stanningfield, Bradfield St Clare, Bradfield St George, Little & Great Whelnetham, Rushbrooke with Rougham and Nowton**. *Crimes in Hawstead, Cockfield and Lawshall though outside of Area B are also reported here.*

The Bury St Edmunds police reporting area (53 parishes & 9 town wards) saw **464** recorded crimes in the month of **January**; reported crimes in/near the parishes mentioned above include:

Great Whelnetham: 1 x O/T **Lawshall: 2 x ASB**
Nowton: 1 x V/S **Rougham: 8 x V/S; 1 x PO**
Stanningfield: 3 x V/S

Also, known incidents in Mar: a cement mixer stolen in Great Whelnetham; vandalism in a park in Great Green, Cockfield; late night intruders in a Lawshall garden; a power extension reel stolen from a Great Whelnetham garden.
