



NHW NETWORK AREA B - LOCAL CRIME STATS FOR MARCH 2022

Just released (www.police.uk – street level crime map), please see below for the recorded crimes that took place in or near villages in our local Bury St Edmunds **Area B** covering the **6 parishes of Bradfield Combust with Stanningfield, Bradfield St Clare, Bradfield St George, Little & Great Whelnetham, Rushbrooke with Rougham and Nowton**. Crimes in **Hawstead, Cockfield and Lawshall** though outside of Area B are also reported here.

The Bury St Edmunds police reporting area (53 parishes & 9 town wards) saw **580** recorded crimes in the month of **March**; reported crimes in/near the parishes mentioned above include:

Bradfield Combust: 2 x V/S **Cockfield: 2 x CD/A**

Great Whelnetham: 2 x D; 2 x CD/A; 3 x V/S; 1 x PO

Lawshall: 1 x ASB

Rougham: 1 x V/S

Stanningfield: 1 x CD/A

(ASB = Anti-Social Behaviour; B = Burglary; BT = Bicycle Theft; CD/A = Criminal Damage/Arson; D = Drugs; O = Other Crime; O/T = Other Theft; PO = Public Order; R = Robbery; S = Shoplifting; TP = Theft from Person; V = Vehicle Crime; V/S = Violence or Sexual; W = Weapons Possession).
