Some of the acknowledged caveats/limitations:

- Not all crimes are reported and therefore recorded
- Some reported crime locations cannot be confirmed by victims
- Some grey areas e.g. Violence & Sexual (incl. Domestic Abuse) are all included in one large category
- Crime categories & stats include very minor to very serious offences
- SCAM phone calls, e-mails, texts etc not included as Action Fraud is responsible

Some observations/comments:

1. Area B (6 parishes) monthly average number of recorded crimes, 14 in 2022 compared to 10 in 2021 (a **40% increase**).

- 2. Area B saw recorded crimes in 11 of the 14 National crime categories, 3 of which accounting for **79%** of local crimes:
 - a. Violence & Sexual (**incl. Domestic Abuse**): 104 in 2022 cf. 55 in 2021 (a **89% increase**). This category accounted for **63%** of recorded crimes in our area.
 - b. Anti-social Behaviour: 15 in 2022 cf.16 in 2021 cf. 29 in 2020 and accounted for **9%** of local crimes.
 - c. Criminal Damage/Arson: 13 in 2022 cf. 22 in 2021 (a **31% decrease**) and accounted for **7%** of recorded crimes in our area.

Also:

- d. Other Theft: 12 reported incidents in 2022 accounting for 7% of recorded crimes.
- e. Burglary: 4 in 2022 (same as 2021) accounting for 2% of local crime.
- f. Vehicle: 5 in 2002 cf. 4 in 2021 and accounted for 3% of recorded crimes.

3. For the year ending June 2022, the Office for National Statistics ranks Suffolk as having the 7th lowest crime rate (cf. 10th in 2021) out of 43 Police Forces (excl. British Transport) across England & Wales, with Suffolk being lowest (cf. second lowest in 2021) in the East of England 6 counties.
